



RTI National Media Handles – 12-Point Posting Guidelines

The National handles of Round Table India showcase the best of Tabling across the country. To keep the content premium and consistent, follow these 12 rules of thumb before submitting any post.

The 12 Rules of Thumb

1. Events or Activities of wide Significance

Only moments that reflect the wide scale, impact, and spirit of Tabling across the country will be featured. Routine events belong to Area and Table handles..

2. Original, High-Quality Images Only

Sharp, well-lit, high-resolution photographs. No COLLAGES. No template-based edited pictures. Let the photo speak for itself.

3. AGMs or Regular Table Meetings

AGMs, NAGMS, NEX will be posted. Regular Table Meetings will not be posted.. Exceptions only for landmark occasions or a Special Guest of National or Regional prominence you wish to highlight.

4. Fellowship = 2+ Tables, 40+ People

Inter-Table fellowship events need a minimum of two participating Tables and at least 40 in attendance. International Fellowships also considered.

5. Milestones Over Invitations/Initiations

Completed milestones get maximum coverage – a finished FTE classroom block, a concluded CS initiative with real outcomes.

6. Community Service Must Show Impact

Unique activities with significant, measurable impact. No religious or political affiliation..

7. No Nominations or Announcements

These belong in official circulars and internal channels, not on the National handles.

8. Freedom Drive Needs the Full Picture

Submit with: number of cities covered, proper road map, RTI publicity impact, and number of Tablers actively participating.

9. All Other Facets – Same Rule of Thumb

Twink events, LAPD, Table Talk articles and every other facet will be considered on the same principle: *significance, scale, and quality of content*.

10. Incomplete Submissions Won't Be Carried

Every submission must include complete details – date, Table(s), Area, venue, highlight, and attendance/impact numbers where relevant.



11. Regarding Sharing of News/ Media Article

Links of news articles of e-paper or from online news websites/magazines will be added to the description of the post or tagging.. The tabler needs to send original pictures of the event.

12. No Alcohol/gambling Pictures

All image submissions of fellowships and socials should not contain the following 2 elements of alcohol and all gambling (Casino, Poker, Teen Patti etc) events.

Submission Checklist

Before sending content to the National Media team, confirm:

- ☐ The event is of national or regional significance (not routine)
- ☐ Original high-resolution photos (no collages / no templates)
- ☐ No religious or political affiliation
- ☐ Attendance / impact numbers included where required
- ☐ Complete event details: date, Table(s), Area, venue, highlight

**Submissions not meeting these guidelines will not be carried on the National handles.*
